

- Through a Donkey

God Revealed in the New Testament

- God Spoke Through <u>Christ</u>
 - John 1:14, 18

God Revealed in the Church Age

- God Speaks Through His Word
 - 1 Corinthians 13:9-12

The **Effect** of the Vision

- Moses

 - Fell on his face
 - Submitted
 - Joshua Served
